The aim of this scholarship is to encourage young women to enter a recognised trade such as, but not limited to, building, plumbing, electrical and mechanics.

To encourage young women from Otago to enter training in a trade, the Zonta Club of Metropolitan Dunedin Inc, is awarding one merit based competitive scholarship of \$1,000 to a female student who is in year 13 and intending to enrol at Otago Polytechnic or an NZQA approved trade or apprenticeship course. It is envisaged the scholarship will be used for course related costs i.e. tools or materials.

The scholarship will be awarded for the first year of the successful applicant's study provided that they can provide evidence of enrolment in their chosen course.

This scholarship aims to recognise a young woman who meets the criteria and demonstrates an ambition to pursue a career in one of the recognised Trades.

General Information

Eligibility

- Academic - Must be a young woman who is in year 13 of secondary school or has completed Year 13 less than 12 months ago, who is planning to pursue a career in one of the recognised Trades and is enrolled at an NZQA approved education provider
- Applicants must reside in Otago, be a New Zealand Citizen or a Permanent Resident of New Zealand
- Must have an active commitment to volunteerism
- Should have knowledge of the programmes of Zonta

- Should be an active supporter of advancing the status of women
- **Application Requirements**
- Completion of this official application form
- Provide two references in support of your application, one should be from an academic contact, the other from a voluntary or community organisation the applicant has been part of
- Verification of enrolment at Otago Polytechnic, or an NZQA approved trade course.

- **Application Process**
- All applications must be received by the Zonta Club of Metropolitan Dunedin Inc, by the deadline of 10 December
- Applications are to be emailed to metropolitandunedin@zonta.org.nz

Evaluation Process

- The Zonta Club of Metropolitan Dunedin Inc, Trades Scholarship is a merit – based competitive Scholarship.
- A panel will consider all applications considering the eligibility criteria. The final evaluation may include an interview and presentation to members of the Zonta Club of Metropolitan Dunedin.
