Entry requirements

- > You must be at least 18 years old by the end of the programme.
- > You must have successful completion of NCEA Level 2 (English and Science credits preferred)
OR hold the New Zealand Certificate in Study and Career Preparation (Level 3) Beauty context (
OR hold the New Zealand Certificate in Makeup and Skin Care (Introduction) (Level 3) OR have relevant and current work experience (of at least two years).
- > Applications from mature students (over 20) are welcome.
- > International students will be individually assessed to ensure you are ready for this study.
- > If English is not your first language, you must provide:
 - > New Zealand University Entrance OR
 - > Overall Academic IELTS 5.5 with no individual band score lower than 5.0 (achieved in one test completed in the last two years), OR
 - > Acceptable alternative evidence of the required IELTS (see here for NZQA proficiency table and here for list of recognised proficiency tests).

If you need to improve your English Language skills, we offer a wide range of English programmes.

If you don't have the entry requirements above, talk to us about whether you have the equivalent skills and knowledge or to determine if this is the right programme for you.
