Drystone construction is as much an art as a science. Building a stone wall is a wonderfully creative and fulfilling experience. One moment you have a space and the next you have a structure. Structures can/will make a statement, whether it be sculptural or practical - the numbers of drystone applications are endless. This is a two-day, weekend course.
