## Learn the traditional craft of dry stone walling.

Drystone construction is as much an art as a science. Building a stone wall is a wonderfully creative and fulfilling experience. One moment you have a space and the next you have a structure. It may have a practical use such as a freestanding wall to keep animals out or to retain a bank or create a terrace. Structures can/will make a statement, whether it be sculptural or practical - the numbers of drystone applications are endless.

This is a two-day course. Each day will start at 9.00am and finish at 3.00pm.

### Course content

In this two-day course, you will build a free-standing wall from foundation to capping using schist stone and basic masonry tools.

### Location

This course will be held at the Bannockburn Road Site (near Cromwell) of the Otago Polytechnic Central Otago campus.

### Materials

Stone and tools are provided.

Please bring your own safety footwear and safety glasses, and bring gloves if you wish to wear them.
