- > Overall Academic IELTS 5.5 with no individual band score lower than 5.0 (achieved in one test completed in the last two years) OR
- > Acceptable alternative evidence of the required IELTS (see here for NZQA proficiency table and here for list of recognised proficiency tests).

2019/2020 course dates

- > 30 September – 19 December 2019 (12 weeks)
- > 20 December 2019 – 5 January 2020 (Christmas and New Year break)
- > 6 January – 5 February 2020 (5 weeks)

There is a total of 17 weeks of study.

There will be a one week break before semester one starts on 17 February 2020.
